#### Our association unites

- Physicians, and/or veterinary surgeons and/or dentists with a full medical, veterinarian or dental qualification who have had special education in homeopathy and hold a diploma recognised by the association (full members).
- Persons with qualification recognised nationally, who have undertaken homeopathic training recognised by the association, such as pharmacists, medical students, chemists and all persons who are licensed health care providers and generally persons who by their profession can contribute to homeopathy, such as scientists, researchers, authors (associate members).

Our association, in the event it is the only national homeopathic medical association applying for LMHI membership, has the right to delegate a licensed homeopathic medical doctor being the National Vice President (NVP) to the International Council. If there are also other national associations affiliated with the LMHI, our association will – in cooperation with the other association(s) – elect one national delegate being the NVP. Our association will communicate the NVP's name and address in writing to the Executive Committee.

Our association undertakes to submit each year an up-to-date directory of all its national members as well as a separate directory of the association's executive board to be incorporated into the annual LMHI directory. This directory will include each member's title, family name, first name, profession, address, postal code, city, country, telephone, fax number and e-mail, as well as the kind of membership, i.e. full or associate. All national members will receive the LMHI publications, such as the *Liga Letter* and the electronic newsletter.

We confirm that the members of our association are licensed homeopathic professionals holding a medical university diploma as well as a homeopathic diploma.

Our association undertakes to pay the annual membership dues, which are in proportion to the actual number of members, to the LMHI's bank account by March 30 each year:

### § 3 of the Constitution

There are three types of members as follows:

- 1. National homoepathic organizations and institutions ("institutional members").
- 2. Physical persons that are physicians, veterinary surgeons and dentists with a full medical, veterinarian or dental qualification of a State University or any other licensing authority duly recognised by the government of the country, in which they practise and who have had special education in homeopathy and hold any kind of diploma recognised by the association ("individual members").
- 3. All persons with qualifications recognised nationally, who have undertaken homeopathic training recognised by the LMHI, such as pharmacists, medical students, chemists and all persons, who are licensed health care providers, such as naturopaths, nurse practitioners, physician's assistants and generally persons who by their profession can contribute to homeopathy, such as scientists, researchers, authors may become associate members of the association ("associate members"). Admission to membership is decided by a two-third majority of the International Council.

#### § 4 of the Constitution

All members pay annual fees. The annual fees for each type of member are fixed by the International Council. The association is liable for its obligations only through its capial. A personal liability of the members is excluded. Members that do not effect the payment of the annual fee may be removed from the association by decision of a simple majority of the Executive Committee.

## § 2 of the Procedures

Any person who wishes to become an Individual member must apply in writing to the General Secretary through the National Vice-President of his country or nation. He must complete the forms prepared by the General Secretary and must be sponsored by two Individual members from this country or nation. The National Vice-President must forward the application to the General Secretary within one month.

Persons who are members of an LMHI Institutional member are exempted from the procedure as per section 1 above.
